Syncrude investigates fatality at its Aurora site

FORT MCMURRAY – JUNE 7, 2021

At approximately 5:00 p.m. on June 6, Syncrude emergency crews responded to an incident involving an employee operating an excavator at its Aurora site. Unfortunately, the employee was fatally injured despite emergency response efforts. No other workers were injured.

“In an organization like ours where safety is the top priority, it’s tremendously difficult when we experience such a tragic loss,” says Andrew Rosser, Senior Vice President, Production. “We are deeply saddened by this loss and our thoughts are with the employee’s family and friends at this difficult time.”

Syncrude is working with the RCMP and Alberta Occupational Health and Safety.

Syncrude has also commenced our own investigation into the incident
